He is the chairman and CEO of Sinovation Ventures, a leading venture capital firm focused on developing the next generation of Chinese high-tech companies.

Previously, Dr. Lee was the president of Google China and a senior executive at Microsoft, SGI, and Apple. Co-chair of the Artificial

Intelligence Council at the World Economic Forum, he has a bachelor's degree from Columbia and a PhD from Carnegie Mellon.

Dr. Lee is the author of AI2041: Ten Visions for Our Future, co-written with award-winning science-fiction writer Chen Qiufan. AI2041 presents a roadmap to educate and explore the opportunities and challenges presented by AI over the coming decades.
